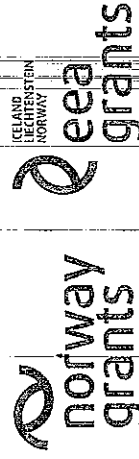
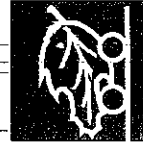
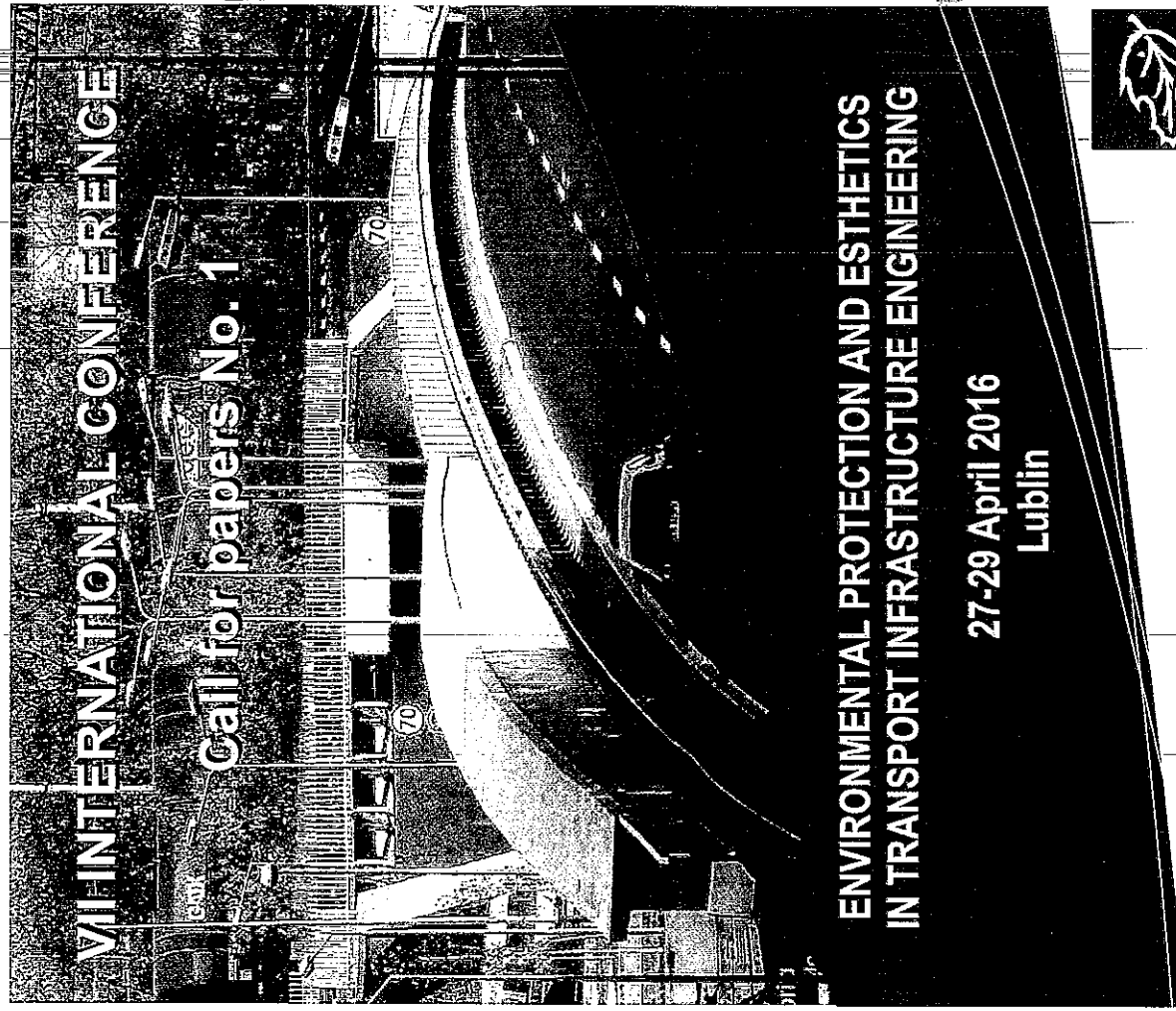

TOPICS OF THE CONFERENCE

The Conference is a periodical forum for exchange of theoretical and practical experience in the field of esthetics and environmental protection in transport infrastructure engineering. The topics will be, as usual, discussed by the scientists and practitioners from Poland and abroad. The participants will come from the sectors of transport infrastructure, ecology, urban planning, as well as modern structures and materials. The aim of the conference is to highlight new challenges and issues of environmental protection, esthetics and modern, innovative solutions in transport infrastructure in the new framework of implementation of transport infrastructure projects. Experience obtained in recent years during modernization and construction of many transportation routes in Poland and in Europe will constitute the base for formulation of recommendations and guidelines to ensure effective solutions in esthetics and environmental protection in transport infrastructure engineering.

The conference is organized in a special time for the Faculty of Civil Engineering of the Lublin University of Technology when new, both for the country and whole Europe, course specializations are introduced i.e. "Ecological Engineering in Transport Infrastructure" and "Civil Engineering Structures and Ecological Engineering". In these new disciplines future building specialists will be formed following a study program supplemented with elements of esthetics and environmental protection. During the conference didactic prospects of the Faculty and new didactic materials will be presented.

The following topics will be discussed during the conference:

1. New approach to teaching of civil engineering with regard to esthetics and environmental protection issues.
2. Esthetics and landscape advantages in all stages of preparation, implementation and operation of transportation infrastructure.
3. Research and assessment of impact in terms of noise, air and water pollution in road and railway engineering.
4. Devices and methods of protection against road noise, water pollution and other negative impacts in road and railway engineering.
5. Urban planning role in transportation engineering.
6. Environmental protection in the process of preparation, implementation and maintenance of construction projects and structures of transport infrastructure.
7. Procedural problems in obtaining administrative decisions and environmental studies in the field of transportation engineering.
8. Innovative materials, technologies and processes in transportation engineering.
9. Use of waste materials in transportation engineering.

CONFERENCE PROGRAM

The conference will be composed of two parts: didactic and general. Programs of two new specializations at the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Architecture of the Lublin University of Technology will be presented in the didactic part of the conference. The papers prepared by the Faculty employees focused on selected subjects will be presented, as well. The scope of all subjects will be presented on posters.

The general part will be made of papers addressing the main topics of the conference and accepted by the Scientific Committee.

CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

The papers prepared for presentation at the Conference will be published in the journal „Budownictwo i Architektura” ("Civil Engineering and Architecture") published by the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Architecture of the Lublin University of Technology, presently with a score of 3 points in the list of Ministry of Science and Higher Education) after review and acceptance by the Scientific Committee. Other papers will be published in the road industry internet portal edroga.pl.
